PROJECT TIME

(I) National Flower

1. On an A4 size sheet/ pastel sheet in landscape form make an attractive border on all four sides.
2. Draw the National Flower of India.
3. Outline your drawing with a black sketch pen.
4. Colour and decorate your drawing to make it look attractive. You can use glitter, sequins, buttons etc. to decorate.
5. Write your name class and section at the bottom of the sheet.

(II) Wall Hanging

1. Make a wall hanging of four pieces using old CDs or cardboard cut-outs of 6x6 inches dimension.
2. Paint, colour and decorate your CDs/ cardboard cut-outs.
3. In capital letters write four polite words (one word in 1 piece) that we should always use (e.g. please, sorry, thank you etc).
4. Paste a ribbon or string at the top to hang your wall hanging.
5. Write your name class and section at the back of your wall hanging

(III) Clean Water Droplet

1. On an A4 size sheet/ pastel sheet in landscape form make an attractive border on all four sides.
2. Draw/ paste picture of a water droplet.
3. Outline the droplet with dark blue sketch pen/ crayon.
4. Colour the droplet with a nice soft shade of blue using crayons/ colour pencils.
5. On either side of the droplet write two ways of saving water.
6. Decorate your work to make it look attractive.
7. Write your name, class and section at the bottom of the sheet.

OR

Hand Printing

1. On an A4 size sheet/ pastel sheet in landscape form make an attractive border on all four sides.
2. Make a hand print of both your hands with the thumbs joined.
3. Once the hand prints are dry outline your hand print with silver/ golden glitter.
4. In the space between your hand prints write a slogan to save water.
5. Write your name, class and section at the bottom of the sheet.

1. Read and learn poem 'Squirrel' (pg-10) from your English book.
2. Do 5 pages of neat hand writing from L-1 'The Little Red Hen' (pg- 17, 18 and 19).

4. Make your own dictionary-
 - Read a storybook / newspaper and find 10 new words with their meanings.
 - Staple 10 origami / pastel sheets together.
 - Write these words in alphabetical order, one on each page. Write their meaning and draw the pictures as well.
 - Make a decorative cover page.
