(III) Project SDG


The sustainable development goals (SDG) are a collection of 17 global goals designed to be a blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all.

Poster

3. Design a colourful and attractive poster depicting and defining the various sources of renewable energy (you can refer to the attached picture).

2. Divide the sheet vertically into 2 sections. Make two boxes with double line border (size 4x4 inches) on the left hand and right hand corners of the sheet.

4. Make cards (two in number) depicting any two forms of renewable energy with illustration, how it works and the good / bad as shown in the picture.
5. Write your name, class and section at the bottom of the sheet.
